

Restoring case for parquet planks Réf. 194735

User manual



The fast, easy to work with and economic method to repair damages in laminate, wood, parquet, cork, linoleum, plastic etc. Can be used on flooring, furniture and other interior decoration.

Contents: 20 nuances of hard wax à 15 gram, melting device, gas, plastic spatula, hand pad

Instructions:

Firstly, test on a place, which is not so visible.

- 1. Prepare the damage by cutting off / rounding uneven edges.
- 2. The melting device is switched on by turning the button from "0" to "I". The gas needs to be ignited in the perforated area by a spark from the cap of the melting device or a lighter.

- 3. Melt the hard wax by holding it to the melting area (top of the device) so that it pours into the damage. Several nuances can be mixed to achieve the best result. When repairing wood, transparent hard wax can be mixed in, to obtain a certain "depth" to the reparation.
- 4. Let the hard wax harden for a couple of seconds, but do not wait too long.
- 5. Carefully cut off excess hard wax with the spatula.
- 6. The "gloss" of the reparation can be altered by carefully rubbing it with a hand pad in the direction of the wood or varnished with a thin layer of lacquer of the desired gloss.
